

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 16 July 2014, the provider notified us that a child had been left in the outdoor area unsupervised by staff. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of significant events. We carried out an unannounced inspection on 4 August 2014. At the inspection the overall effectiveness of the setting was judged to be outstanding. Swift action had been taken to address procedures to ensure that children are effectively supervised and that all staff are aware of their responsibilities to safeguard children. We are satisfied with the positive and prompt action the provider has taken. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
