

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 23 September 2014, the provider notified us of an event whereby a child was able to leave the premises with an unidentified individual. This notification means the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

We carried out a visit to the premises where it established the setting had taken appropriate action by putting in place a password system and revisiting the procedure for the collection of children with staff. Staff had further training in safeguarding procedures and as a result Ofsted did not need to take any further action.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
