

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 13th November 2013 the provider notified us that a child had been left unsupervised in the setting. At inspection we looked into the notification to see whether the setting was meeting the safeguarding and welfare requirements. In particular the setting's safeguarding policy and practice and child supervision. We found that staff had been retrained in their roles and responsibilities to supervise children, the safeguarding policies and procedures had been reviewed and all staff had been re-inducted with the new procedures. Furthermore, new registration systems have been put into place and the management conduct regular supervision checks.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
