

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 2 October 2013, the provider notified us that they were not complying with the requirements for qualified staff ratios. The notification meant that the provider met their responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of a significant event likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider. At an inspection we looked into this concern to see whether the setting was meeting the Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements; in particular Staff qualifications, training, support and skills. We found that there were insufficient numbers of staff working at the setting to ensure that qualified staff ratios were consistently met overall. Following our inspection, we sent the provider a notice to improve that asked them to maintain ratios of qualified staff at all times. The provider remains registered.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
