

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Following a recent incident in the setting, a member of staff did not follow safeguarding procedures by reporting the incident immediately to a senior member of staff. On 17 October 2013, the management were notified of the incident and the provider appropriately notified Ofsted. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of significant events. At an inspection we looked at the concerns to see whether the provider was meeting the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements relating to Safeguarding Practice, Safeguarding Policy, Risk Assessment and General Suitable People Matters. The management undertook a full investigation into the circumstances of the incident. The member of staff involved in the incident no longer works in the setting. The inspection found that the provider was meeting the requirements and no further action was taken.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
