

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 21 November 2013, we received a notification that raised concerns about general suitability matters. Ofsted investigated this concern to see whether the provider was meeting the Early years Foundation Stage welfare requirements for Suitable People. Following the visit, Ofsted sent a notice of action to improve. A follow up inspection has been completed and finds the provider is complying with the action set by Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
