

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 21 February 2014, we received a notification from the provider that raised concerns about how children were safeguarded in the setting. At inspection we looked into this concern to see if the setting was meeting the Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements with specific regard to child supervision. At inspection the management team and staff demonstrated a comprehensive understanding of how to safeguard and protect children. They have thoroughly reviewed their procedures for moving children from different rooms within the setting including reviewing the ratios of adult to children. Furthermore, all staff are booked on lone worker training within the next month, they have reflected on their practice including writing reflective logs. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
