

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

Following an inspection on 23 October 2013 which resulted in a judgement of 'inadequate', a welfare requirements notice was sent setting out actions to: undertake observational assessments in order to understand children's levels of achievement, complete a short written progress check for children between the age of two and three years, and to maintain records and effectively obtain and share information with parents and other carers or key persons. A monitoring visit was carried out on 26 February 2014. Through discussion and documentation, the inspector concluded that the childminder had taken prompt and effective action in making improvements as identified in the welfare requirements notice and notice of actions to improve. A full inspection was scheduled and took place on 8 April 2014. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
