

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 26 March 2014 the provider notified us that a complaint had been made concerning staff's knowledge and understanding of the safeguarding policy and procedure. At an inspection we looked into the concern to see whether the setting was meeting the safeguarding requirements and promoting children's welfare. The inspection found that the provider had taken appropriate action to address the concerns and no further action was required. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
