Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider understands the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements. There are systems to monitor children's development and the educational programmes offered.
- Staff have a good understanding of how children learn and develop. They recognise the importance of observing children and planning activities based on their interests. They use resources and activities to promote children's engagement in learning.
- Staff have a sound knowledge of how to keep children safe, including what they would do if they have concerns about a child. Policies, procedures and risk assessments ensure that hazards are minimised. Staff consider the health, safety and welfare of children as part of daily practice.
- Staff have a good understanding of how to support children's emotional well-being as they settle into the club.
- Staff understand how to manage children's behaviour in a positive way.
- The provider has a strong commitment to continually improve the setting. They have devised appropriate procedures to obtain the views of staff, parents and children to accurately identify priorities for improvement.
- There are systems to promote professional development. Staff benefit from regular supervision and frequent opportunities for training to enhance their existing knowledge and increase the care that they provide.
- Staff have a good understanding of the importance of working in partnerships with parents, professionals and other providers.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector sampled documentation for the setting, including staff qualification certificates and policies.
- The inspector viewed the areas that the children use.

Arts Play Pynes holiday play scheme and Can Play Pynes out of school club is one of four clubs run by the Community Arts Network. It registered in 2006 and operates from the main hall of Pynes Infant and Nursery School, Bideford, in North Devon. The club is open each weekday from 3.30pm to 6pm during term time and from 8.30am to 6pm in the school holidays. There are two members of staff who work with the children and both hold level 3 qualifications. At the time of the inspection, there were no children in the early years age range on roll.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
