

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 15 July 2016 the childminder notified Ofsted of an incident at their house. We needed to investigate this concern to see whether the setting was meeting the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage welfare requirements relating to safeguarding. We do not investigate to prove or disprove a complaint but we look into the information we receive to see if the childcare provider is meeting all legal requirements.

We carried out a planned visit to the premises. We found that the childminder had revised her risk assessment to ensure that children were more easily seen and heard while playing and updated her knowledge. We agreed with the action she had already taken and took no further action. The provider remains suitable for registration.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
