

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 8 June 2016 the provider notified us about an incident that had happened in nursery. We needed to investigate this situation to see whether the setting was meeting the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage welfare requirements, relating to safeguarding and notification to other agencies. We spoke to other agencies responsible for safeguarding children and we carried out an unannounced visit to the premises. We found that the provider had worked with other agencies to ensure that children were protected.

The provider acknowledged that their lack of knowledge and experience in dealing with this specific situation meant there had been a delay in recognising the incident as a safeguarding issue. There had therefore been some delay in referring concerns to the relevant agencies. This could have compromised children's welfare. The provider then worked with other agencies to arrange relevant training for all staff and revised aspects of their risk assessment. The provider remains suitable for registration.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
