

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On the 14 March 2017, we received a complaint that raised concerns about how well the provider was meeting safeguarding requirements. As a result we carried out a full inspection. The outcome of the inspection was inadequate.

Following the inspection, we issued a welfare requirements notice that required the provider to:

ensure that the staff supervision system provides staff with the support, coaching and training they need to address weaknesses in their practice and promote the welfare and learning of the children

ensure that all staff access relevant continuous professional development opportunities so that they are able to offer quality learning and development experiences for children

ensure that an effective key person system is in place to provide a settled relationship for children and parents, and that children's welfare, emotional development and individual learning needs are addressed effectively.

In addition, we raised a notice to improve that asked the provider to:

improve the monitoring of children's development to ensure it is assessed accurately and used to recognise their progress, understand their needs and plan activities to support their individual learning.

We carried out a compliance visit to the nursery on 30 August 2017 to check the provider was complying with the actions following the inspection and welfare requirements notices set. We found that the provider had taken appropriate action and is now complying with requirements for registration.

The next step will be a full inspection.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
