

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of complaint

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 12 December 2017 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We issued a notice of action to improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted. Action needed. Review risk assessments to ensure that all hazards posed to children are assessed, with particular reference to pets. 31/01/2018.

The provider has reviewed their risk assessments. We are satisfied with the action taken.
