

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 22 February 2018, the provider notified us about a child receiving a serious injury while playing in the setting. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of serious accidents and injuries. An unannounced visit to the setting was carried out on 17 April 2018 and we found that the provider was meeting the welfare requirements for First aid, Child Supervision, Staff deployment, Risk assessment and Changes that must be notified to Ofsted. However, not all the requirements for Accident or injury had been fully met. We have issued a Notice of Actions to Improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed:

Accident or injury 3.50

improve the recording of accidents or injuries and first-aid treatment and ensure that parents are informed of any accident or injury sustained by the child on the same day - by 4 May 2018

Accident or injury 3.51

ensure that local child protection agencies are notified about any serious accidents or injury to a child - by 4 May 2018

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying

regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
