Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has knowledge of safeguarding and child protection issues. She is familiar with the procedures to report any concerns about a child's welfare, including allegations, to the relevant authorities.
- The childminder knows how to evaluate the provision and how to maintain her professional development to enhance her practice and improve children's experience.
- The childminder understands how to observe, plan and assess children's learning. She knows how to provide opportunities for children to enjoy and to help them make good progress with their development.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnerships with parents to share information about children's care and learning and to encourage their involvement in children's development.
- The childminder understands how to support children to develop their personal and social skills. She knows how to set boundaries to teach children right from wrong.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector looked at the childminder's policies and documents she intends to use when caring for children.
